In the Matter of JUDY K. WOLF	ORDER

On October 15, 2014, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an Order Instituting Proceedings against Judy K. Wolf, pursuant to Sections 15(b) and 21C of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Sections 203(f) and 203(k) of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940. The hearing is scheduled to commence on February 23, 2015, in Washington, D.C.

On December 11, 2014, this Office received a request for guidance on the presentation and organization of exhibits from the Division of Enforcement. In this Order, I set forth guidelines for the parties to follow.

- 1. The parties shall exchange exhibits no later than January 26, 2015, but need not file the exhibits. The parties need not provide their exhibits to my Office before the hearing.
- 2. At the start of the hearing, the parties should provide me with electronic versions of their exhibits in PDF format, for example, through a compact disc. The parties need not provide separate hardcopies for me at the hearing, as I intend to use a computer during the hearing and will have access to the electronic exhibits.
- 3. If audio or video clips are offered in evidence, the parties are encouraged to prepare transcripts of the clips.
- 4. The courtroom is set up to accommodate projections of images on a screen and monitors. If the parties intend to display images on the monitors, they should coordinate with this Office to ensure the number of monitors is adequate.
- 5. The parties are encouraged to cooperate with and assist each other in the presentation of electronic exhibits during the hearing, where reasonable.
- 6. The parties may number the exhibits as they find appropriate, I have no preference about this.
