Based on the parties' post-hearing submissions to date, as well as the evidence adduced at the hearing, I am disinclined to rely upon the Wells submission of Respondent Thomas R. I am providing notice of this determination in order to prevent any party from placing undue reliance on Division Exhibit 157 in its responsive post-hearing submissions as evidence to prove a fact or facts in dispute. Because this Order may motivate the parties to adjust their responsive post-hearing submissions, presently due on January 16, 2015, I hereby extend that filing date until January 20, 2015, in the event that any party elects to adjust those filings in light of this Order.
