ORDER

The hearing in this administrative proceeding was held from November 17, 2014, through November 25, 2014.

On February 2, 2015, the parties filed their responsive post-hearing briefs. Today, the parties notified me that the Division's brief exceeded the twenty page limit I had previously imposed by five pages. *See Dennis J. Malouf*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 2059, 2014 SEC LEXIS 4515, at *4 (Nov. 28, 2014). The Division requested leave to exceed the twenty page limit and have its twenty-five page reply brief considered. Respondent opposed this request, noting the substantial time, effort, and expense it expended to comply with the page limit. I GRANT the Division's request and will allow Respondent to supplement and refile his brief with an additional five pages if he so chooses. Any such supplement shall be filed by February 10, 2015.

Also on February 2, 2015, Respondent filed additional proposed findings of fact. The Division requested permission to respond to these proposals by February 6, 2015, which I GRANT.
