STAY ORDER

ROBERT C. WEAVER, JR., ESQ.

On November 12, 2014, the Securities and Exchange Commission (Commission) issued an Order Instituting Public Administrative Proceedings (OIP) and Imposing Temporary Suspension Pursuant to Rule 102(e)(3)(i)(A) of the Commission's Rules of Practice (Rule), 17 C.F.R. § 201.102(e)(3)(i)(A), against Robert C. Weaver, Jr., Esq. (Weaver). *Robert C. Weaver, Jr., Esq.*, Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) Release No. 73578, 2014 SEC LEXIS 4317. The OIP temporarily suspended Weaver from appearing or practicing before the Commission as an attorney based on a finding that on April 14, 2014, Weaver consented to the entry of a judgment in *SEC v. Coldicutt*, No. 2:13-cv-01865-RGK-VBK (C.D. Cal.). On December 1, 2014, Weaver petitioned the Commission to lift the temporary suspension pursuant to Rule 102(e)(3)(ii). On December 10, 2014, the Commission's Office of General Counsel (OGC) filed an Opposition to Weaver's petition. On December 29, 2014, the Commission issued an Order Denying Motion to Lift Temporary Suspension and Directing Hearing. *Robert C. Weaver, Jr., Esq.*, Exchange Act Release No. 73949, 2014 SEC LEXIS 5071.

OGC and Weaver have jointly moved to stay this proceeding, pending Commission consideration of an offer of settlement. The joint motion represents that OGC and Weaver have reached an agreement in principle to a settlement on all major terms.

The motion is GRANTED and this proceeding is STAYED, subject to compliance with Rule of Practice 161(c)(2), 17 C.F.R. § 201.161(c)(2).
