ORDER POSTPONING
HEARING AND SCHEDULING
PREHEARING CONFERENCE

The Securities and Exchange Commission (Commission) instituted this proceeding with an Order Instituting Proceedings (OIP), pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act), on March 11, 2015, and the hearing is scheduled to commence on March 30, 2015. The OIP alleges that Respondent is a corporation with a class of securities registered with the Commission pursuant to Section 12(g) of the Exchange Act and has repeatedly failed to file required periodic reports. The Division of Enforcement is seeking to revoke the registration of Respondent's securities.

The OIP provides that Respondent's Answer is due within ten days of service of the OIP on it. *See* OIP at 2; 17 C.F.R. § 201.220(b). If Respondent fails to file an Answer within the time provided it will be deemed to be in default, and the undersigned will enter an order revoking the registration of its securities. *See* OIP at 2-3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a), .220(f). To allow time for service and for an Answer, the hearing will be postponed *sine die*, and a prehearing conference will be held by telephone on May 26, 2015, at 10:00 a.m. EDT, if the proceeding has not been resolved by then.
