ORDER POSTPONING HEARING
AND SCHEDULING PREHEARING
CONFERENCE

On May 12, 2015, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an Order Instituting Proceedings (OIP) pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, alleging that Respondents have securities registered with the Commission and are delinquent in their periodic filings. A hearing is currently scheduled for May 28, 2015.

The Division of Enforcement filed a declaration representing that InferX Corp. and Sedona Corp. were served with the OIP by May 13, 2015, in accordance with Commission Rule of Practice 141(a)(2)(ii), 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(ii). I find that InferX Corp. and Sedona Corp. were served by May 13, 2015, and their Answers are due by May 26, 2015. OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.160(b), .220(b).

The declaration also represents that service was accomplished as to Computer Learning Centers, Inc., stating that the address shown on its most recent EDGAR filing is a bankruptcy trustee's address on Lee Highway in Fairfax, Virginia, and that the Commission's Office of the Secretary sent a copy of the OIP to that address. *See* 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(ii). I do not see that address on the company's most recent EDGAR filing, and find it is unclear whether service on Computer Learning Centers, Inc., has been effected.

The hearing scheduled to begin on May 28, 2015, is POSTPONED and a telephonic prehearing conference shall be held on June 12, 2015, at 2:00 p.m. EDT. If InferX Corp. or Sedona Corp. fails to file an Answer by May 26, 2015, participate in the telephonic prehearing conference, or otherwise defend the proceeding, it will be deemed in default, the proceeding will be determined against it, and the registration of its securities will be revoked. OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a)(1)-(2), .220(f), .221(f).

The Division is directed to file a supplementary declaration of service as to Computer Learning Centers, Inc., by June 5, 2015.
