ORDER SCHEDULING  
PREHEARING  
CONFERENCE AND TO  
SHOW CAUSE

On September 9, 2014, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an Order Instituting Administrative Proceedings (OIP) against Respondents pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. On November 13, 2014, I issued an Initial Decision of Default as to all Respondents except Opera Jet International Ltd. *Bio Oil Nat'l Corp.*, Initial Decision Release No. 707, 2014 SEC LEXIS 4302, *finality order*, Exchange Act Release No. 73934, 2014 SEC LEXIS 4999 (Dec. 24, 2014).

On May 18, 2015, a Declaration of Service was filed stating that a process server served the OIP and other documents on Opera Jet by leaving a copy of the papers with the Delaware Secretary of State on May 8, 2015. I find that Opera Jet was served in accordance with Commission Rule of Practice 141(a)(2)(ii), 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(ii), on May 8, 2015. *See* 8 Del. C. § 321(b). Opera Jet's Answer was due by May 18, 2015. OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. § 201.220(b). As of today, Opera Jet has not filed an Answer.

Accordingly, I ORDER that on or before Friday, June 5, 2015, Respondent Opera Jet International Ltd. shall SHOW CAUSE why the registrations of its securities should not be revoked by default due to its failure to file an Answer or otherwise defend this proceeding. *See* 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a)(2), .220(f). If Opera Jet fails to respond to this Order, it will be deemed in default, the proceedings will be determined against it, and the

registration of its securities will be revoked. OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a)(2), .220(f).

Furthermore, I ORDER that a telephonic prehearing conference shall be held at 11:30 a.m. EDT on June 10, 2015.
