ORDER FOLLOWING PREHEARING  
CONFERENCE

On May 20, 2015, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an Order Instituting Proceedings (OIP) against Gedrey Thompson, pursuant to Section 203(f) of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940.

A telephonic prehearing conference was held today, attended by counsel for the Division of Enforcement. The Division represented that its efforts to serve Mr. Thompson with the OIP by mail have not been successful and described its intent to serve Mr. Thompson by publication of the OIP in two newspapers in Jamaica, where the Division believes he is located.

As discussed at the conference, it is ORDERED that by July 14, 2015, the Division shall file a declaration detailing its previous efforts to locate and serve Mr. Thompson, the evidence that Mr. Thompson is currently in Jamaica, the logistics of how the Division will effect service by publication, and legal support for the proposition that “the method of service used is not prohibited by” Jamaican law. 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(iv).
