ORDER SEALING DOCUMENTS

The Securities and Exchange Commission (Commission) issued an Order Instituting Proceedings on February 21, 2014, pursuant to Section 15(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. On September 5, 2014, I issued an initial decision. *Gary L. McDuff*, Initial Decision Release No. 663, 2014 SEC LEXIS 3207. On April 23, 2015, the Commission vacated the initial decision and remanded this proceeding for further development of the record. *See Gary L. McDuff*, Exchange Act Release No. 74803, 2015 SEC LEXIS 1657. I instructed the parties to file supplemental briefing. *Gary L. McDuff*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 2783, 2015 SEC LEXIS 2274 (June 8, 2015).

On June 24, 2015, the Division of Enforcement filed its supplemental briefing, attaching several exhibits. At least one of these exhibits contains third parties' personally identifiable or sensitive financial information, including, but not necessarily limited to, a social security number and home addresses. I therefore SEAL the Division's exhibits submitted with its supplemental briefing and ORDER the Division to file by July 20, 2015, redacted versions of these exhibits with all personally identifiable or sensitive financial information removed. The unredacted versions of these exhibits may only be disclosed to the staff of the Commission, Respondent, and Respondent's family.
