ORDER POSTPONING
HEARING AND SCHEDULING
PREHEARING CONFERENCE

The Securities and Exchange Commission (Commission) issued an Order Instituting Administrative Proceedings (OIP) on June 18, 2015, alleging that Respondent GSP-2, Inc., has securities registered with the Commission pursuant to Section 12(g) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and has not filed required periodic reports. A hearing is scheduled to begin on July 13, 2015.

The Division of Enforcement filed a Declaration to Assist Secretary with Record of Service on June 24, 2015, that shows CSC Services of Nevada, Inc., is GSP-2's registered agent in Nevada, and it was served with the OIP on June 19, 2015. GSP-2 was required to file an answer within ten days after service of the OIP. OIP at 2; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.160(a)-(b), .220(b). Accordingly, GSP-2's answer to the OIP was due by July 2, 2015. As of the date of this Order, no answer has been filed.

I POSTPONE the hearing and ORDER a telephonic prehearing conference on July 24, 2015, at 3:00 pm EDT. I will default GSP-2 and revoke the registration of its registered securities if it does not file an answer, participate in the prehearing conference, or otherwise defend the proceeding. OIP at 2; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a), .220(f), .221(f).
