ORDER POSTPONING HEARING AND  
SCHEDULING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

On July 8, 2015, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an Order Instituting Proceedings (OIP) pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, alleging that Respondents have securities registered with the Commission and are delinquent in their periodic filings.

On July 16, the Division of Enforcement filed a declaration of service, establishing that Respondents were served with the OIP by July 15, in accordance with Rule of Practice 141(a)(2)(ii), 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(ii). As such, Respondents' Answers are due by July 28. OIP at 2; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.160(b), .220(b).

I POSTPONE the hearing currently scheduled for July 30, 2015, and schedule a telephonic prehearing conference for 11:00 a.m. EDT that same day. If Respondents fail to timely file Answers, appear at the prehearing conference, or otherwise defend the proceeding, they will be deemed in default, the proceeding will be determined against them, and the registrations of their securities will be revoked. OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a), .220(f), .221(f).
