SCHEDULING ORDER

On August 3, 2015, the parties timely submitted a joint prehearing conference statement, which addresses each numbered item in 17 C.F.R. § 201.221(c), and specifically represents that the parties have agreed to resolve the issues of disgorgement, prejudgment interest, and civil penalties through a motion for summary disposition, pursuant to 17 C.F.R. § 201.250. Based on this prehearing conference statement, this prehearing schedule is ORDERED:

- August 18, 2015: The Division of Enforcement's motion for summary disposition is due. The motion for summary disposition, exclusive of declarations and exhibits, must not exceed thirty-five pages. *See* 17 C.F.R. § 201.250(c).
- September 18, 2015: Respondents' opposition to the Division's motion for summary disposition is due. The opposition, exclusive of declarations and exhibits, must not exceed thirty-five pages.
- September 28, 2015: The Division's reply in further support of its motion for summary disposition is due. The reply must not exceed fifteen pages.
- October 8, 2015: Respondents' sur-reply in response to the Division's reply is due. The sur-reply must not exceed fifteen pages.

Further, if the parties jointly agree that oral argument by videoconference would be helpful to the resolution of the remaining issues in this proceeding, then they must jointly move by October 9, 2015, for oral argument, proposing days on which oral argument, either in November or December 2015, might be held. If oral argument is held, it will not exceed four hours.

Finally, the parties are asked to attach any exhibits to declarations, *see* 17 C.F.R § 201.250(a), and to submit courtesy copies of all briefs and motions to alj@sec.gov in both text-searchable PDF format and MS Word format.
