ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE AND
RESCHEDULING PREHEARING
CONFERENCE

On August 18, 2015, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an Order Instituting Administrative Proceedings (OIP) against Respondent pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. A prehearing conference is currently scheduled for September 14, 2015.

Respondent was served with the OIP on August 20, 2015, and its Answer was due by September 2. *Internal Fixation Sys., Inc.*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 3076, 2015 SEC LEXIS 3534 (Aug. 28, 2015). To date, Respondent has not filed an Answer.

Accordingly, it is ORDERED that on or before September 15, 2015, Respondent shall SHOW CAUSE why the registration of its securities should not be revoked by default due to its failure to file an Answer or otherwise defend this proceeding. If Respondent fails to respond to this Order or appear at the prehearing conference, it will be deemed in default, the proceeding will be determined against it, and the registration of its securities will be revoked. OIP at 2-3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a)(1)-(2), .220(f), .221(f).

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the prehearing conference is RESCHEDULED for September 15, 2015, at 10:00 a.m. EDT.
