ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

On August 18, 2015, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an Order Instituting Proceedings (OIP) pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, alleging that Respondents have securities registered with the Commission and are delinquent in their periodic filings. A prehearing conference is scheduled for October 1, 2015.

Respondents were served with the OIP by August 28, 2015, in accordance with 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(ii), (iv), and their Answers to the OIP were due by September 10, 2015. *See* OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.160(a)-(b), .220(b). To date, no Respondent has answered the OIP.

It is ORDERED that Respondents shall SHOW CAUSE by September 24, 2015, why this proceeding should not be determined against them due to their failures to file Answers or otherwise defend this proceeding. If any Respondent fails to respond to this Order, it will be deemed in default, the proceeding will be determined against it, and the registration of its securities will be revoked. *See* OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a)(2), .220(f).
