ORDER EXTENDING STAY

On August 24, 2015, I granted a motion to stay these proceedings, conditioned on the submission of a signed offer of settlement to the Securities and Exchange Commission by September 16, 2015. *Albert J. Scipione*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 3062, 2015 SEC LEXIS 3461.

Today, the Division of Enforcement submitted a status report, explaining that the initial signed settlement offer that was submitted to the Commission was missing some necessary language. The Division represents that it is in the process of obtaining Respondent's signature on a second settlement offer containing all the necessary language. As a result, the Division requests that I extend the deadline for submitting the settlement offer to October 7, 2015. Accordingly, for good cause shown and consistent with 17 C.F.R. § 201.161(b), I GRANT the Division's request.
