ORDER DIRECTING THE DIVISION OF  
ENFORCEMENT TO FILE AN UPDATED  
DECLARATION OF SERVICE AND  
AFFIDAVIT

On April 9, 2015, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an Order Instituting Administrative Proceedings (OIP) pursuant to Section 15(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. I previously found that Respondent Craig Danzig was served with the OIP on April 16, 2015, and that his Answer was due May 6, 2015. *Craig Danzig*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 2653, 2015 SEC LEXIS 1792 (May 8, 2015). On June 23, 2015, I found Danzig in default for failure to file an Answer or otherwise defend this proceeding, and directed for the Division of Enforcement to file a motion for sanctions. *Craig Danzig*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 2848, 2015 SEC LEXIS 2564. Thereafter, the Division filed its motion. To date, Danzig has not filed any response.

On September 21, 2015, the Division notified this Office that Danzig had recently contacted the Division by phone claiming that he was not personally served with the OIP.

The Division shall file by October 2, 2015: (i) an updated declaration of service from the process server, confirming whether Danzig was personally served with the OIP on April 16, 2015, and the circumstances in which service was made; and (ii) an affidavit memorializing the contents of Danzig's recent phone call with the Division and confirming whether the Division has the correct address for Danzig on file.
