The Securities and Exchange Commission instituted this proceeding with an Order Instituting Proceedings on July 30, 2015, pursuant to Section 15(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, as a follow-on proceeding based on *SEC v. Balboa*, No. 1:11-cv-8731 (S.D.N.Y.). Previously, the Division of Enforcement was granted leave, pursuant to 17 C.F.R. § 201.250, to file a motion for summary disposition; a hearing, expected to last one day, was scheduled for March 24, 2016, in Washington, D.C., should the proceeding not be resolved by summary disposition. *Gilles T. De Charsonville*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 3609, 2016 SEC LEXIS 573 (A.L.J. Feb. 17, 2016); Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 3245, 2015 SEC LEXIS 4315 (A.L.J. Oct. 21, 2015). The motion for summary disposition and responsive pleadings have been filed and are pending. Since a ruling may not be issued before March 24, 2016, the contingent hearing date will be postponed, pursuant to 17 C.F.R. § 201.161, to April 21, 2016.
