STAY ORDER

The Securities and Exchange Commission instituted this proceeding on May 28, 2015. It was stayed, pursuant to 17 C.F.R. § 201.210(c)(3), on the Application to Intervene and Motion to Stay, filed June 5, 2015, by the United States Attorney for the Eastern District of New York+ during the pendency of a criminal proceeding arising out of the same facts at issue. *William Quigley*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 2880, 2015 SEC LEXIS 2680 (A.L.J. June 30, 2015). The Division of Enforcement (Division) was ordered to report every ninety days on the status of the parallel criminal proceeding and the continued appropriateness of staying this proceeding. *Id.*

On March 28, 2016, the Division reported that it understood that Quigley had entered a guilty plea and that sentencing was scheduled for July 13, 2016. The Division also reported that it reached an agreement in principle on a partial settlement of this administrative proceeding and that the parties requested that the stay be continued pursuant to 17 C.F.R. § 201.161(c)(2) in order to document the agreement and submit it to the Commission for approval.

The stay currently in effect will be amended insofar as necessary to permit: (1) Quigley to execute a settlement offer; and (2) the Division to submit the settlement offer to the Commission for its consideration.¹ The Division will continue to report on the status of the parallel criminal proceeding every ninety days and, as soon as possible, following sentencing, whenever that occurs.

¹ See 17 C.F.R. § 201.210(c)(3): “A stay granted under this paragraph (c)(3) may be granted for such a period and upon such conditions as the . . . [Administrative Law Judge] deems appropriate.”
