SECOND STAY ORDER

On February 23, 2016, I stayed this proceeding as the parties had agreed in principle to a settlement on all major terms. *Jason Bo-Alan Beckman*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 3634, 2016 SEC LEXIS 660. The stay, however, lapsed because a signed settlement offer was not submitted to Commission staff within fifteen business days of the stay as required by Rule of Practice 161(c)(2), 17 C.F.R. § 201.161(c)(2). *Jason Bo-Alan Beckman*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 3734, 2016 SEC LEXIS 1112 (ALJ Mar. 24, 2016).

On April 1, the Division submitted a second motion to stay this proceeding. The Division represents that it received a signed and notarized settlement offer from Respondent on March 31, which it will submit for the Commission's consideration. The Division further represents that a joint motion was not filed by the parties due to Respondent's incarcerated status.

As Respondent had consented to the prior stay of this proceeding, I construe this second motion as a joint motion to stay within the meaning of Rule of Practice 161(c)(2). The motion is GRANTED and this proceeding is STAYED, subject to compliance with that rule, requiring that this office be notified promptly if any of the requirements of the rule are not met. *See* 17 C.F.R. § 201.161(c)(2).
