ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE,  
POSTPONING HEARING, AND  
SCHEDULING PREHEARING  
CONFERENCE

On November 21, 2016, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an order instituting proceedings (OIP) pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, alleging that Respondent has securities registered with the Commission and is delinquent in its periodic filings. A hearing is scheduled to commence on December 16, 2016.

On December 2, 2016, the Division of Enforcement filed a declaration establishing that Respondent was served with the OIP by U.S. Postal Service delivery on November 25, 2016, in accordance with 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(ii), (iv). Accordingly, Respondent's answer to the OIP was due by December 8, 2016. *See* OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.160(b), .220(b). To date, Respondent has not answered the OIP.

Accordingly, it is ORDERED that Respondent SHOW CAUSE by December 22, 2016, why this proceeding should not be determined against it due to its failure to file an answer or otherwise defend this proceeding. If Respondent fails to respond to this order and file its answer, it will be deemed in default, the proceeding will be determined against it, and the registrations of its securities will be revoked. *See* OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a)(2), .220(f).

It is further ORDERED that the hearing scheduled to begin on December 16, 2016, is POSTPONED, and a telephonic prehearing conference shall be held at 11:00 a.m. Eastern on January 24, 2017, if the proceeding has not been resolved by then.
