EXTENSION ORDER

On January 27, 2017, the Division of Enforcement requested that the deadline for the parties' post-hearing briefs be extended from February 15 to February 17, 2017, and that the deadline for their responsive post-hearing briefs be extended from March 1 to March 15, 2017. The Division cited the limited availability of two of its attorneys as the reason for the request, and noted that Respondent does not object.

For good cause shown under 17 C.F.R. § 201.161, the Division's request is GRANTED. Post-hearing briefs are now due February 17, 2017, and responsive post-hearing briefs are now due March 15, 2017. As noted previously, the parties may file proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law, consistent with 17 C.F.R. § 201.340, at the time opening post-hearing briefs are filed.
