On January 8, 2025, Nano Magic Inc. filed an application for an award of attorney's fees and other expenses under the Equal Access to Justice Act (EAJA). This followed Nano Magic's petition before the Securities and Exchange Commission to terminate the suspension in the trading of Nano Magic's securities, and the Commission's vacatur of its trading suspension order *nunc pro tunc*.
