Rule 6.4.

Series of Options Open for Trading

(a) - (f) No Change

.03 The Exchange may select up to [43] <u>60</u> classes of its listed options on individual stocks [or Exchange-Traded Fund Shares] for which the interval of strike prices will be \$2.50 where the strike price is greater than \$25 but less than \$[75]100. The Exchange will list \$2.50 strikes prices between \$50 and \$[75]100 provided the \$2.50 strike prices between \$50 and \$[75]100 are no more than \$10 from the closing price of the underlying stock on its primary market on the preceding day. In addition to those options selected by the Exchange, the strike price interval may be \$2.50 in any multiply traded option once another exchange trading that option selects such options.

An option class shall remain in the \$2.50 Strike Price Program until otherwise designated by the Exchange and a decertification notice is sent to the Options Clearing Corporation.
