

FINAL JUDGMENT

The U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission ("Commission") having filed a Complaint; Defendants, BigPlayStocks.com, Inc. and John R. Luers having failed to file an answer or otherwise appear in this action; the Clerk having made an entry of default as to both Defendants; and the Commission having filed a motion for default judgment:

I.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that Defendants, Defendants' agents, servants, employees, attorneys, assigns, and all persons in active concert or participation with them who receive actual notice of this Final Judgment by personal service or otherwise are permanently restrained and enjoined from violating, directly or indirectly, Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (the "Exchange Act") [15 U.S.C. § 78j(b)] and Rule 10b-5 promulgated thereunder [17 C.F.R. § 240.10b-5], by using any means or instrumentality of interstate commerce, or of the mails, or of any facility of any national securities exchange:

- (a) to employ any device, scheme, or artifice to defraud;

(b) to make any untrue statement of a material fact or to omit to state a material fact necessary in order to make the statements made, in the light of the circumstances under which they were made, not misleading; or

(c) to engage in any act, practice, or course of business which operates or would operate as a fraud or deceit upon any person,

in connection with the purchase or sale of any security.

II.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that Defendant, John R. Luers ("Luers"), shall pay a civil penalty in the amount of \$110,000 pursuant to Section 21(d)(3) of the Exchange Act [15 U.S.C. § 87u(d)(3)]. Luers shall make this payment within ten (10) business days after entry of this Final Judgment by certified check, bank cashier's check, or United States postal money order payable to the Securities and Exchange Commission. The payment shall be delivered or mailed to the Office of Financial Management, Securities and Exchange Commission, Operations Center, 6432 General Green Way, Mail Stop 0-3, Alexandria, Virginia 22312, and shall be accompanied by a letter identifying BigPlayStocks.com, Inc. and John R. Luers as defendants in this action; setting forth the title and civil action number of this action and the name of this Court; and specifying that payment is made pursuant to this Final Judgment. Copies of such check and accompanying letter shall be simultaneously submitted to Mary E. Keefe, Regional Director, Securities and Exchange Commission, Midwest Regional Office, 175 West Jackson Blvd., Suite 900, Chicago, Illinois 60604.

III.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that this Court shall retain jurisdiction of this matter for the purposes of enforcing the terms of this Final Judgment.
