

**FINAL JUDGMENT SETTING CIVIL MONEY PENALTY
AGAINST DEFENDANT STUART A. SLONIN**

THIS CAUSE comes before the Court upon plaintiff Securities and Exchange Commission's ("SEC" or "Commission") January 27, 2003 Motion to Set Motion Civil Penalties Against Defendants ("Penalty Motion"). The Court has considered the Penalty Motion, the SEC's February 11, 2003 Penalty Recommendation in Support of the Penalty Motion, supporting exhibits and memorandum of law, the opposition and financial information submitted by Defendant Stuart A. Slonin ("Defendant"), and the Court having conducted a hearing on February 14, 2003, and being otherwise fully advised herein, accordingly, it is hereby:

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the SEC's Penalty Motion is GRANTED and this Final Judgment Setting Civil Money Penalty Against Stuart A. Slonin ("Final Judgment") is entered for the SEC and against Defendant as follows:

I.

CIVIL PENALTY

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Defendant shall pay a civil penalty in the amount of \$ 45,000, pursuant to Section 20(d) of the Securities Act, 15 U.S.C. § 77t(d) and Section 21(d)(3) of the Exchange Act, 15 U.S.C. § 78u(d)(3).

Defendant shall pay the civil penalty ordered herein by making monthly payments in the amount of \$1,250 per month over the course of three (3) years, due on the first of each month commencing on March 1, 2003 through and including February 1, 2006. Defendant shall send a U.S. postal money order, certified check, bank cashier's check or bank money order in the amount of \$1,250 and made payable to the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission, and transmitted to the Comptroller, U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission, 450 Fifth Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20549, under cover of a letter that identifies Defendant, the caption and case number of this action and the name of this Court. Copies of such check and accompanying cover letter shall be simultaneously transmitted to Teresa J. Verges, Regional Trial Counsel, U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission, Southeast Regional Office, 801 Brickell Avenue, Suite 1800, Miami, Florida 33131.

II.

RETENTION OF JURISDICTION

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that this Court shall retain jurisdiction over this matter and Defendant in order to implement and carry out the terms of all Orders and Decrees that may be entered and/or to entertain any suitable

application or motion for additional relief within the jurisdiction of this Court, and will order other relief that this Court deems appropriate under the circumstances.
