**[PROPOSED] FINAL JUDGMENT  
IMPOSING CIVIL PENALTY AGAINST  
VINCENT STECKLER**

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20 Plaintiff Securities and Exchange Commission ("Plaintiff" or "Commission") has filed its  
21 Complaint in this action. Defendant Vincent Steckler ("Defendant" or "Steckler") has entered a  
22 general appearance; consented to the Court's jurisdiction over Defendant and the subject matter  
23 of this action; consented to entry of this Final Judgment Imposing Civil Penalty Against Vincent  
24 Steckler ("Final Judgment") without admitting or denying the allegations of the Complaint  
25 (except as to jurisdiction); waived findings of fact and conclusions of law as provided by Rule 52  
26 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure; and waived any right to a jury trial and to appeal from  
27 this Final Judgment:  
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I.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that Defendant shall pay a civil penalty of \$35,000 pursuant to Section 21(d)(3) of the Exchange Act, 15 U.S.C. § 78u(d)(3). Defendant shall make this payment within ten (10) business days after entry of this Final Judgment by certified check, bank cashier's check, or United States postal money order payable to the Securities and Exchange Commission. The payment shall be delivered or mailed to the Office of Financial Management, Securities and Exchange Commission, Operations Center, 6432 General Green Way, Mail Stop 0-3, Alexandria, Virginia 22312, and shall be accompanied by a letter identifying Vincent Steckler as a defendant in this action; setting forth the title and civil action number of this action and the name of this Court; and specifying that payment is made pursuant to this Final Judgment. A copy of the payment and the letter shall be simultaneously delivered or mailed to Helene Morrison, District Administrator, Securities and Exchange Commission, 44 Montgomery Street, Suite 2600, San Francisco, California 94104. Defendant shall pay post-judgment interest on any delinquent amounts pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1961.

II.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that the Consent of Vincent Steckler to the Entry of Final Judgment Imposing Civil Penalty (the "Consent") is incorporated herein with the same force and effect as if fully set forth herein, and that Defendant shall comply with all of the undertakings and agreements set forth therein.

III.




