

1 Plaintiff Securities and Exchange Commission ("Commission") filed a 2 Motion for Entry of Final Judgment of Disgorgement, Prejudgment Interest, and 3 Civil Penalties ("Motion"), which was heard by the Court. The Court hereby 4 GRANTS the Commission's Motion. 5 I. 6 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that Defendant 7 Robert J. Pratt is liable for disgorgement of \$628,947, representing profits gained 8 as a result of the conduct alleged in the Complaint, together with prejudgment 9 interest thereon in the amount of \$112,682.98 and a civil penalty in the amount of 10 \$628,947 pursuant to Section 20(d) of the Securities Act of 1933, 15 U.S.C. § 11 77t(d), and Section 21(d)(3) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, 15 U.S.C. § 12 78u(d)(3). Defendant shall satisfy this obligation by paying \$1,370,576.98 within 13 14 days after entry of this Final Judgment by certified check, bank cashier's check, or United States postal money order payable to the Securities and Exchange 14 15 Commission. The payment shall be delivered or mailed to the Office of Financial 16 Management, Securities and Exchange Commission, 100 F Street, NE, Stop 6042, 17 Washington DC 20549, and shall be accompanied by a letter identifying Robert J. 18 Pratt as a defendant in this action; setting forth the title and civil action number of 19 this action and the name of this Court; and specifying that payment is made 20 pursuant to this Final Judgment. Defendant shall pay post-judgment interest on 21 any delinquent amounts pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1961. The Commission shall 22 remit the funds paid pursuant to this paragraph to the United States Treasury. 23 II. 24 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that this 25 Court shall retain jurisdiction of this matter for the purposes of enforcing the terms 26 of this Final Judgment. 27 Dated: May 25 2012 HONORABLE JAMES L.
