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	Pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(a)(1), plaintiff Securities and Exchange		
22	Commission ("Commission") hereby voluntarily dismisses with prejudice its unresolved claims for		
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24	disgorgement and civil penalties against defendant David Scott Cacchione ("Cacchione"). Federal		
	Rule of Civil Procedure 41(a)(1) permits a plaintiff to dismiss claims voluntarily where the opposing		
25	party, such as Cacchione here, has not filed an answer or summary judgment motion with the Court.		
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27	The Commission brought the above-titled action against Cacchione on March 24, 2009. At		
	the time of filing, Cacchione consented to a final judgi	ment that permanently enjoined him from

committing any future violations of the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws. The Court			
entered the Final Judgment against Cacchione on March 31, 2009. Section IV of the Final Judgment			
states that "Defendant shall pay disgorgement of ill-gotten gains, prejudgment interest thereon, and a			
civil penalty pursuant to Section 20(d) of the Securities Act [15 U.S.C. § 77t(d)] and Section 21(d)(3)			
of the Exchange Act [15 U.S.C. § 78u(d)(3)] and Section 209(e) of the Advisers Act [15 U.S.C. §			
80b-9]. The Court shall determine the amounts of the disgorgement and civil penalty upon motion of			
the Commission." Thus, the only remaining issues in the above-titled action are the amount of			
disgorgement and civil penalties to be imposed against Cacchione.			
On October 7, 2009, this Court sentenced Cacchione to a prison term of 60 months and			
imposed a restitution order of \$47,542,887.00 in a related criminal action, <i>United States of America</i> v			
David Scott Cacchione, CR-09-00296 CRB, for the same conduct at issue in the Commission's suit.			
In light of Cacchione's criminal sentence, including his prison term and restitution order, the			
Commission hereby dismisses its claims for disgorgement and civil penalties against Cacchione,			
pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(a)(1).
