FINAL JUDGMENT OF MONETARY RELIEF AGAINST DEFENDANT MOHIT A. KHANNA

[Dkt. Nos. 159, 178]

The Securities and Exchange Commission ("Commission") having filed a Complaint and Defendant Mohit A. Khanna ("Khanna") having entered a general appearance; consented to the Court's jurisdiction over him and the subject matter of this action; consented to entry of this Final Judgment without admitting or denying the allegations of the Complaint (except as to jurisdiction); waived findings of fact and conclusions of law; waived any right to appeal from this Judgment; and the parties having moved for entry of judgment:

I.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED THAT Khanna is liable for disgorgement of \$15,148,938.41, together with prejudgment interest thereon in the amount of \$2,594,728.52, for a total judgment of \$17,743,666.93 to be paid within fourteen days after entry of this Final Judgment to Charles G. LaBella as the Court-appointed Permanent Receiver of Defendant MAK 1 Enterprises Group, LLC and its subsidiaries and affiliates. Khanna shall simultaneously transmit photocopies of such payment and letter to the Commission's counsel in this action. By making this payment, Khanna relinquishes all legal and equitable right, title, and interest in such funds, and no part of the funds shall be returned to Khanna.

II.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that the Consent is incorporated herein with the same force and effect as if fully set forth herein, and that Khanna shall comply with all of the undertakings and agreements set forth therein.

III.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that this Court shall retain jurisdiction of this matter for the purposes of enforcing the terms of this Final Judgment.

IV.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that all other Orders of this Court shall remain in full force and effect.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
