
ORDERED AND ADJUDGED as follows:

1. Final Judgment as to disgorgement, interest, and penalties be and the same is hereby **ENTERED** in favor of Plaintiff Securities and Exchange Commission and against Defendant Frank C. Calmes in the amount of \$1,886,918.00, together with post-judgment interest thereon at the rate of 0.12% from the date of this Final Judgment, for all of which let execution issue;

2. Defendant Calmes shall pay pre-judgment interest in the amount of \$468,441.00, for all of which let execution issue; and

3. Defendant Calmes shall pay a civil penalty in the amount of \$5,000.00, for all of which let execution issue.
