3 at the hearing on this matter, and being fully advised in the  
4 premises, hereby GRANTS the Commission's motion, and enters judgment  
5 against the Defendant pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. Proc. 56.

7 IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Defendant shall be  
8 liable, jointly and severally with Lion's Share Ventures and Brent  
9 Morris, for disgorgement of his ill-gotten gains in the amount of  
10 \$173,318, together with prejudgment interest, calculated pursuant to  
11 28 U.S.C. § 1961, in the amount of \$9,336, totalling \$182,654.  
12 Defendant shall pay the above amount of disgorgement with  
13 prejudgment interest within thirty days of the entry of this  
14 Judgment.

16 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Defendant  
17 shall be liable for civil penalties resulting from his violations in  
18 the amount of \$30,202. Defendant shall pay the above amount of  
19 civil penalties within thirty days of the entry of this Judgment.
