[PROPOSED] FINAL JUDGMENT OF DISGORGEMENT AND CIVIL PENALTIES AGAINST JONATHAN SHOUCAIR

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The Court, having considered the Commission's motion, the memoranda and other evidence filed with the Court, and oral argument at the hearing on this matter, and being fully advised in the premises, hereby GRANTS the Commission's motion, and enters judgment against the Defendant pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. Proc. 56.

I.

IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Defendant shall be liable, jointly and severally with Madison Consulting Group, Inc., and Michael W. Engelhardt, for disgorgement of his ill-gotten gains in the amount of \$627,148, together with prejudgment interest, calculated pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1961, in the amount of \$33,783, totalling \$660,931. Defendant shall pay the above amount of disgorgement with prejudgment interest within thirty days of the entry of this Judgment.

II.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Defendant shall be liable for civil penalties resulting from his violations in the amount of \$70,388. Defendant shall pay the above amount of civil penalties within thirty days of the entry of this Judgment.

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There being no just reason for delay, the Clerk of the Court is directed to enter this judgment forthwith.
