IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that Defendant Stephens, and his agents, servants, employees, and attorneys, and all persons in active concert or participation with any of them, who receive actual notice of this Final Judgment by personal service or otherwise, and each of them, are permanently restrained and enjoined from, directly or indirectly:

A. making use of any means or instruments of transportation or communication in interstate commerce or of the mails to sell the securities of any issuer, through the use or medium of any prospectus or otherwise, unless and until a registration is in effect

as to such securities;

- B. carrying or causing to be carried through the mails or in interstate commerce, by any means or instruments of transportation, for the purpose of sale or for delivery after sale, the securities of any issuer, unless and until a registration statement is in effect as to such securities; and
- C. making use of any means or instruments of transportation or communication in interstate commerce or of the mails to offer to sell or offer to buy, through the use or medium of any prospectus or otherwise, the securities of any issuer, unless and until a registration statement has been filed with the Commission as to such securities, or while a registration statement as to such securities is the subject of a refusal order or stop order or (prior to the effective date of the registration statement) any public proceeding or examination under Section 8 of the Securities Act of 1933 [15 U.S.C. § 77h];

in violation of Sections 5(a) and 5(c) of the Securities Act of 1933 ("Securities Act") [15 U.S.C. §§ 77e(a) & 77e(c)]; provided, however, that nothing in Part I of this Final Judgment shall apply to any security or transaction that is exempt from the provisions of Section 5 of the Securities Act [15 U.S.C. § 77e].

II.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that Defendant Stephens and his agents, servants, employees, and attorneys, and

all persons in active concert or participation with any of them, who receive actual notice of this Final Judgment by personal service or otherwise, and each of them, are permanently restrained and enjoined from, directly or indirectly, making use of the mails or any means or instrumentality of interstate commerce to effect any transaction in, or to induce or attempt to induce the purchase or sale of, any security (other than an exempted security or commercial paper, bankers' acceptances, or commercial bills) unless and until becoming registered in accordance with Section 15(b) of the Exchange Act [15 U.S.C. § 780(b)] in violation of Section 15(a)(1) of the Exchange Act [15 U.S.C. § 780(a)(1)].

III.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that Defendant Stephens pay a civil penalty in the amount of \$5,000 pursuant to Sections 20(d)(1) and 20(d)(2) of the Securities Act [15 U.S.C. §§ 77t(d)(1) and 77t(d)(2)] and Section 21(d)(3) of the Exchange Act [15 U.S.C. § 78u(d)(3)]. Such payment may be made in two installments. The first installment of \$2,500.00 shall be paid within thirty (30) days of Entry of Judgment. The second installment of \$2,500.00 shall be paid not later than ninety (90) days of Entry of Judgment. This civil money penalty: (1) shall be paid by United States Postal Money Order, Certified Check, bank cashier's check or bank money order; (2) shall be made payable to the United States Treasury; (3) shall be handdelivered or Mailed to the Comptroller, Securities and Exchange Commission, Operations Center, 6432 General Green Way, Stop 0-3,

Alexandria, VA 22312, and (4) shall be submitted under a cover letter that identifies Stephens as a Defendant in these proceedings, and states the file numbers of these proceedings, A copy of this cover letter and money order or check shall be sent to Trial Counsel for the Commission at the Pacific Regional Office, Securities and Exchange Commission 5670 Wilshire Boulevard, 11th Floor Los Angeles, California 90036.

IV.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that the provisions of the Consent filed concurrently with this Final Judgment are incorporated herein with the same force and effect as if fully set forth herein and that Defendant shall comply with his Consent.

٧.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that this Court shall retain jurisdiction over this action to determine the liability of any remaining defendants in this action, to implement and to enforce the terms of this Final Judgment and all other orders and decrees that may be entered herein, and to grant such other relief as the Court may deem necessary and just.
