




18 Plaintiff Securities and Exchange Commission ("Commission"),
19 having filed and served upon Defendant Brent A. Jones ("Jones") a
20 Summons and Complaint in this action; Jones having admitted service
21 upon him of the Summons and Complaint in this action and the
22 jurisdiction of this Court over him and over the subject matter of
23 this action; having been fully advised and informed of his right to
24 a judicial determination of this matter; having waived the entry of
25 findings of fact and conclusions of law as provided by Rule 52 of
26 the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure; having consented to the entry
27 of this Final Judgment Of Permanent Injunction And Other Relief
28 Against Defendant Brent A. Jones ("Final Judgment"), without

1 admitting or denying the allegations in the Complaint except as
2 specifically set forth in the Consent Of Defendant Brent A. Jones To
3 Entry Of Final Judgment Of Permanent Injunction And Other Relief
4 ("Consent"); no notice of hearing upon the entry of this Final
5 Judgment being necessary; and this Court being fully advised:

6 I.

7 IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Jones and his agents,
8 servants, employees and attorneys, and all persons in active concert
9 or participation with any of them, who receive actual notice of this
10 Final Judgment by personal service or otherwise, and each of them,
11 are permanently restrained and enjoined from, directly or
12 indirectly, in connection with the purchase or sale of any security,
13 by the use of any means or instrumentality of interstate commerce,
14 or of the mails, or of any facility of any national securities
15 exchange:

- 16 A. employing any device, scheme, or artifice to defraud;
17 B. making any untrue statement of a material fact or
18 omitting to state a material fact necessary in order to
19 make the statements made, in the light of the
20 circumstances under which they were made, not misleading;
21 or
22 C. engaging in any act, practice, or course of business
23 which operates or would operate as a fraud or deceit upon
24 any person;

25 in violation of Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934
26 [15 U.S.C. § 78j(b)] and Rule 10b-5 [17 C.F.R. § 240.10b-5].

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ii.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Jones is assessed, and shall pay to the Commission for delivery to the United States Treasury, civil penalties in the amount of \$5,000 under the Securities Enforcement and Penny Stock Reform Act of 1990 pursuant to Section 20(d) of the Securities Act [15 U.S.C. Section 77t(d)] and Section 21(d)(3) of the Exchange Act [15 U.S.C. Section 78(d)(3)]. Jones shall pay the above penalty within 30 days of entry of this Final Judgment. This payment shall be made by cashier's check, certified check or postal money order, payable to the United States Treasury, and shall be transmitted to the Comptroller, Comptroller, Securities and Exchange Commission, Operations Center, 6432 General Green Way, Stop 0-3, Alexandria, VA 22312, under cover of a letter which identifies the defendant, the name and case number of this litigation and the name of the Court. A copy of the cover letter shall be simultaneously transmitted to counsel for the Commission at its Los Angeles office. Jones acknowledges that the Commission's determination not to seek a greater amount in civil penalties is based upon Jones' sworn representations in his Statement of Financial Condition. This judgment is contingent upon the accuracy and completeness of that Statement of Financial Condition. If at any time following the entry of this Final Judgment the Commission obtains information indicating that Jones' representations to the Commission concerning his assets, income, liabilities, or net worth were fraudulent, misleading, inaccurate or incomplete in any material respect as of the time such representations were made, the Commission may, at its sole discretion and without prior notice to Jones, petition this

1 Court for an order requiring Jones to pay an additional amount in
2 civil penalties. In connection with any such petition, the only
3 issues shall be whether the financial information provided by Jones
4 was fraudulent, misleading, inaccurate or incomplete in any material
5 respect as of the time such representations were made, and the
6 amount of civil penalty to be imposed. Jones may not, by way of
7 defense to such petition, challenge the validity of this Consent or
8 the Final Judgment, contest the allegations in the Complaint filed
9 by the Commission, or assert that the payment of a civil penalty
10 should not be ordered.

11 III.

12 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the provisions
13 of the Consent filed concurrently with this Final Judgment are
14 incorporated by this reference, and that Jones shall comply with the
15 Consent.

16 IV.

17 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that this Court
18 shall retain jurisdiction over this action for all purposes,
19 including to determine the liability of any remaining defendants in
20 this action, to implement and enforce the terms of this Final
21 Judgment and other orders and decrees which may be entered, and to
22 grant such other relief as this Court may deem necessary and just.
