**ORDER OF SUSPENSION OF  
TRADING**

It appears to the Securities and Exchange Commission (“Commission”) that there is a lack of current and accurate information concerning the securities of InventaBioTech Inc. (“INVB”)<sup>1</sup> (CIK No. 1421603), a noncompliant Colorado corporation located in San Antonio, TX with a class of securities registered with the Commission pursuant to Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (“Exchange Act”) Section 12(g) because it is delinquent in its periodic filings with the Commission, having not filed any periodic reports since it filed a Form 10-Q for the period ended September 30, 2018. On February 27, 2020, the Commission’s Division of Corporation Finance sent a delinquency letter to INVB requesting compliance with its periodic filing requirements, but INVB did not receive the delinquency letter due to its failure to maintain a valid address on file with the Commission as required by Commission rules (Rule 301 of Regulation S-T, 17 C.F.R. Section 232.301 and Section 5.4 of EDGAR Filer Manual). As of May 18, 2020, the common stock of INVB was quoted on OTC Link operated by OTC Markets Group Inc. (formerly “Pink Sheets”) (“OTC Link”), had five market makers, and was eligible for the “piggyback” exception of Exchange Act Rule 15c2-11(f)(3).

The Commission is of the opinion that the public interest and the protection of investors require a suspension of trading in the securities of INVB. Therefore, it is ordered, pursuant to Section 12(k) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, that trading in the securities of INVB is suspended for the period from 9:30 a.m. EDT on August 28 2020, through 11:59 p.m. EDT on September 11, 2020.
