Self-Regulatory Organizations; NYSE Arca, Inc.; Notice of Withdrawal of a Proposed Rule Change to Extend the Implementation Date For Certain Changes to the NYSE Arca Rule 5 and Rule 8 Series

On August 3, 2017, NYSE Arca, Inc. ("Exchange") filed with the Securities and Exchange Commission ("Commission"), pursuant to Section 19(b)(1) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934¹ and Rule 19b-4 thereunder,² a proposed rule change to extend the implementation date for certain changes to the NYSE Arca Rule 5 and Rule 8 Series relating to continued listing standards for exchange-traded products. The proposed rule change was published for comment in the <u>Federal Register</u> on August 22, 2017.³ The Commission received one comment letter on the proposed rule change.⁴ On September 22, 2017, the Exchange withdrew the proposed rule
