The SEC Division of Enforcement investigates possible violations of securities laws and recommends Commission action, either in a federal court or before an administrative law judge, and negotiates settlements. As an adjunct to the SEC's civil enforcement authority, we work closely with law enforcement agencies in the U.S. and around the world to bring criminal cases.

If you are interested in providing expert testimony in a U.S. Federal Court relevant to securities law enforcement actions, SEC encourages you to respond to the Federal Business Opportunities (FBO) notice (www.fbo.gov), when available. We also encourage Small Businesses (SB), Veteran-Owned small businesses (VOSB), Service-Disabled Veteran Owned businesses (SDVOB), HUBZones, Woman-Owned small businesses (WOSB), Economically Disadvantaged Women-Owned small businesses (EDWOSB), Small Disadvantaged Businesses (SDB), and Section 8(a) small businesses to respond.
