## Question 256.15

**Question:** May a Canadian issuer filing under the use financial statements contained in an MJDS use its most recent filing on Form 40-F, F-9 or F-10 to satisfy the information requirements of Rule 502(b)?

Answer: Yes. Although Rule Rules 502(b)(2)(iii)(DB) permits (1) and (2) permit a foreign private issuer to use its most recent Form 20-F or Form F-1 financial statements prepared in accordance with IFRS to meet Rule 502's information requirements, but does not mention the MJDS forms, Financial statements prepared in accordance with IFRS that are included in an MJDS filer may use its most recent filing on Form 40-F, F-9 or F-10 may be used to satisfy Rule 502(b)'s information requirements.
