

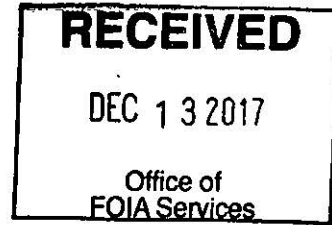

This letter is in response to your request dated December 12, 2017, and received in this office on December 13, 2017, for records of consumer complaints, civil complaints, investigations, or preliminary inquiries concerning Monday Properties.

Based on the information you provided in your letter, we conducted a thorough search of the SEC's various systems of records, but did not locate or identify any records responsive to your request.

If you still have reason to believe that the SEC maintains the type of records you seek, please provide us with additional information, which could prompt another search. Otherwise, we conclude that no responsive records exist and we consider this request to be closed.

You have the right to appeal the adequacy of our search and/or finding of no responsive records to the SEC's General Counsel under 5 U.S.C. § 552(a)(6), 17 CFR § 200.80(d)(5)(iv). The appeal must be received within ninety (90) calendar days of the date of this adverse decision. Your appeal must be in writing, clearly marked "Freedom of Information Act Appeal," and should identify the requested records. The appeal may include facts and authorities you consider appropriate.
