This Court, having granted the Plaintiff Securities and Exchange Commission's summary judgment motion, enters this Final Judgment Imposing Civil Penalties ("Final Judgment") against Ira Posnansky a/k/a Ira Post ("Posnansky").

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that pursuant to Section 20(d) of the Securities Act, 15 U.S.C. § 77u(d), and Section 21(d)(3) of the Exchange Act, 15 U.S.C. § 78u(d)(3), Defendant Posnansky shall pay civil penalties in the amount of \$26,000. Defendant Posnansky shall pay this penalty within sixty days of entry of this Final Judgment by cashier's check, certified check or postal money order. This payment shall be made payable to the United States Treasury and shall be transmitted to the Office of Financial Management, 6432 General Green Way, Stop 0-3, Alexandria, Virginia 22312, under cover of a letter which identifies the defendant, the name and case number of this litigation and the name of the Court. A copy of the cover letter and check shall be simultaneously transmitted to counsel for the Commission at its Los Angeles office, located at 5670 Wilshire Boulevard, 11th Floor, Los Angeles, California 90036.

II.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that this Court shall retain jurisdiction over this action for all purposes, including to implement, enforce and carry out the terms of this Final Judgment and all other orders and decrees that may be entered herein, and to grant such other relief as this Court may deem necessary and just.
