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1 The motion of plaintiff, Securities and Exchange Commission
2 (“Commission”), pursuant to Rule 56, Fed. R. Civ. P., for summary judgment
3 setting civil penalties, disgorgement and prejudgment interest against Defendant
4 Christine Favara, came before the Court for hearing on June 26, 2006. The Court,
5 having considered the Commission’s motion, the Memoranda of Points and
6 Authorities, the Proposed Statement of Uncontroverted Facts and Conclusions of
7 Law, the declaration of Pamela Chattoo, and other documents filed in support of
8 the motion, and all other evidence and argument presented regarding the Motion,
9 orders as follows:

10 **I.**

11 **IT IS ORDERED** that the Commission’s motion for summary judgment
12 against Favara is hereby **GRANTED**.

13 **II.**

14 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that Favara shall be liable for a civil penalty in
15 the amount of \$100,000 pursuant to Section 20(d) of the Securities Act and
16 Section 21(d)(3) of the Exchange Act. Favara shall make this payment within ten
17 (10) business days after entry of the Judgment by certified check, bank cashier’s
18 check, or United States postal money order payable to the United States Treasury.
19 The payment shall be delivered to the Office of Financial Management, Securities
20 and Exchange Commission, Operations Center, 6432 General Green Way, Stop 0-
21 3, Alexandria, VA 22312, under cover of a letter that identifies the defendant, the
22 name and case number of this litigation, and the court. Copies of this letter and
23 the certified check shall be simultaneously transmitted to counsel for the
24 Commission in this action at its Pacific Regional Office.

25 **III.**

26 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that Favara shall be liable for disgorgement of
27 \$15,000, representing profits gained as a result of the conduct alleged in the
28 Complaint, and prejudgment interest of \$478.29. Favara shall satisfy her

1 disgorgement and prejudgment interest by paying \$15,478.29 within ten (10) days
2 following the date of entry of the Judgment in the form of a cashier's check,
3 certified check or United States postal money order payable to United States
4 Treasury. The payment shall be delivered to the Office of Financial Management,
5 Securities and Exchange Commission, Operations Center, 6432 General Green
6 Way, Stop 0-3, Alexandria, VA 22312, under cover of a letter that identifies the
7 defendant, the name and case number of this litigation, and the court. Copies of
8 this letter and the certified check shall be simultaneously transmitted to counsel
9 for the Commission in this action at its Pacific Regional Office.

10 **IV.**

11 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that this Court shall retain over this action for
12 all purposes, including the purpose of implementing and carrying out the terms of
13 this Final Judgment and all other orders and decrees that have been and may be
14 entered herein and to entertain any suitable application or motion for additional
15 relief within the jurisdiction of this Court.

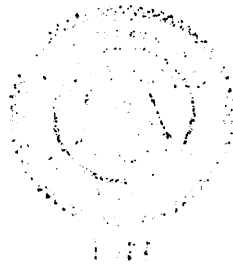
