**ORDER DISMISSING CERTAIN
CLAIMS AGAINST DEFENDANT
GOLDSTEIN AND RELATED
RELIEF DEFENDANTS**

Pursuant to Local Rules 7-1 and 52-9, Plaintiff, the United States Securities and Exchange Commission (“SEC” or “Commission”), Defendant Jerold V.


Goldstein (“Defendant Goldstein”) and Relief Defendants Linda I. Goldstein and The Linda I. Goldstein Family Trust, through their counsel, have stipulated and agreed to an Order dismissing with prejudice the Commission’s prayers for disgorgement including prejudgment interest and a civil penalty against Defendant Goldstein and dismissing with prejudice the Commission’s claims against the Relief Defendants related to Defendant Goldstein.

1. This case was initially filed as No. 04-CV-4340 in the United States District Court for the Northern District of Illinois (the “Illinois Court”). Among other things, the Commission’s Complaint prayed that Defendant Goldstein be ordered to pay disgorgement including prejudgment interest and a civil penalty.
2. On March 21, 2005, the Illinois Court entered an Order transferring this case to this Court, where the case was docketed as CV 05-3059 RL (RCx).
3. On October 28, 2005, the Commission filed its Third Amended Complaint which, among other things, added as a Relief Defendants Linda I. Goldstein and The Linda I. Goldstein Family Trust.
4. On January 4, 2008, the Court entered a Final Judgment by consent against Defendant Goldstein.

5. Accordingly, the parties have agreed and stipulated to an Order 1) dismissing with prejudice the Commission's prayer for disgorgement including prejudgment interest and a civil penalty against Defendant Goldstein and 2) dismissing with prejudice the Commission's claims against Relief Defendants Linda I. Goldstein and The Linda I Goldstein Family Trust.
