JUDGMENT
06-CV- 1578 (JG)

An Order of Honorable John Gleeson, United States District Judge, having been filed on September 30, 2009, directing the Clerk of Court to enter judgment in favor of the plaintiff as follows: (1) Zafar is permanently enjoined from committing future violations of the Securities Act, the Exchange Act, and Rule 10b-5; (2) Zafar is ordered to disgorge \$290,193.14; and (3) Zafar is ordered to pay a civil penalty of \$290,193.14; and to the extent Zafar pays or has paid restitution as ordered in the criminal judgment, such payments will offset his disgorgement obligation under the present judgment; it is

ORDERED and ADJUDGED that judgment is hereby entered in favor of the plaintiff, Securities and Exchange Commission and against defendant, Faisal Zafar, as follows: (1) Faisal Zafar is permanently enjoined from committing future violations of the Securities Act, the Exchange Act, and Rule 10b-5; (2) Faisal Zafar is ordered to disgorge

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\$290,193.14; and (3) Faisal Zafar is ordered to pay a civil penalty of \$290,193.14; and that to the extent Faisal Zafar pays or has paid restitution as ordered in the criminal judgment, such payments will offset his disgorgement obligation under the present judgment.
