# FINAL JUDGMENT AS TO DEFENDANTS COLONIAL INVESTMENT MANAGEMENT LLC, COLONIAL FUND LLC AND CARY G. BRODY

#### WHEREAS,

- 1. Plaintiff Securities and Exchange Commission ("Commission") commenced this action on October 15, 2007, against Defendants Colonial Investment Management LLC ("CIM"), Colonial Fund LLC ("Colonial") and Cary G. Brody ("Brody") (collectively, the "Defendants"); filed an Amended Complaint on November 14, 2007 ("Complaint"); and a trial as to the Commission's claim and requests for relief against Defendants was held before the Honorable P. Kevin Castel on May 5-7, 11-12 and 18, 2009; and
- 2. On July 7, 2009, the Court issued its Opinion setting forth the Court's Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, which form the bases for this Final Judgment as to Defendants Colonial Investment Management LLC, Colonial Fund LLC and Cary G. Brody ("Final Judgment"), including that CIM, Colonial and Brody violated Rule 105 [17 C.F.R. § 242.105] of Regulation M under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 ("Exchange Act");

#### NOW THEREFOR,

I.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that Defendants and Defendants' officers, agents, servants, employees, attorneys, and all persons in active concert or participation with them who receive actual notice of this Final Judgment by personal service or otherwise are permanently restrained and enjoined from violating, directly or indirectly, Rule 105 of Regulation M under the Exchange Act, 17 C.F.R. § 242.105.

II.

Brody are jointly liable for disgorgement in the amount of \$990,284.63, together with prejudgment interest thereon at the IRS underpayment rate, calculated from December 16, 2004 through July 7, 2009, in the amount of \$339,769.69, for a total of \$1,330,054.32. Defendant Colonial is liable for disgorgement in the amount of \$487,752.13, together with prejudgment interest thereon at the IRS underpayment rate, calculated from December 16, 2004 through July 7, 2009, in the amount of \$167,349.27, for a total of \$655,101.40. Defendant Brody shall pay a civil penalty in the amount of \$450,000, pursuant to 15 U.S.C. § 78u(d)(3). Defendants shall satisfy their respective obligations under this paragraph by paying the amounts ordered within ten (10) business days after entry of this Final Judgment by certified check, bank cashier's check, or United States postal money order payable to the Securities and Exchange Commission. The payments shall be delivered or mailed to the Office of Financial Management, Securities and Exchange Commission, Operations Center, 6432 General Green Way, Mail Stop 0-3, Alexandria, Virginia 22312, and shall be accompanied by a letter identifying the Defendant's name as a

defendant in this action; setting forth the title and civil action number of this action and the name of this Court; and specifying that payment is made pursuant to this Final Judgment. Defendants shall pay post-judgment interest on any delinquent amounts pursuant to 28 USC § 1961. The Commission shall remit the funds paid pursuant to this paragraph to the United States Treasury.

III.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that this Court shall retain jurisdiction of this matter for the purposes of enforcing the terms of this Final Judgment.

IV.

There being no just reason for delay, pursuant to Rule 54(b) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, the Clerk is ordered to enter this Final Judgment forthwith and without further notice.
