

ORDER

Plaintiff's notice of dismissal of all unadjudicated claims against defendants PrivateFX Global One Ltd., SA, 36 Holdings, Ltd. and Daniel J. Petroski (Dkt. 194) is GRANTED. This dismissal does not affect any relief already granted by the Court in this action, including ancillary relief.

Plaintiff's motion to dismiss all remaining claims against defendant Robert D. Watson (Dkt. 195) is GRANTED. It is therefore ORDERED that the Commission's civil penalty claims under Sections 20(d)(1) of the Securities Act of 1933 [15 U.S.C. § 77t(d)] and Section 21(d) of the Exchange Act [15 U.S.C. § 78u(d)] and the Commission's claims for disgorgement plus prejudgment interest against Robert D. Watson are DISMISSED.
