JUDGMENT

This matter came before the Court on Plaintiff Securities and Exchange Commission's ("Plaintiff") Motion for Entry of Default Judgment. After full consideration of all admissible evidence and documents submitted, the Court granted Plaintiff's Motion against Defendants David Praise, a/k/a Musa Mohamed, a/k/a David Praise Edwards, a/k/a David Enrique Fernandez ("Praise"), Martin Burke ("Burke"), and William Dippolito ("Dippolito") (collectively, "Defendants").

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED:

1. Defendants are permanently enjoined from violating Section 10(b), 15 U.S.C. § 78j(b), and Rule 10b-5, 17 C.F.R. § 240.10b-5;
2. Praise and Burke are permanently enjoined from violating Sections 5(a), 5(c), and 17(a), 15 U.S.C. §§ 77e(a), (c), 77q(a); and

1 3. A civil penalty of \$130,000 shall be imposed against each Burke and Dippolito.

2 IT IS SO ADJUDGED.
