Pursuant to the Court's July 8, 2010 Order Granting Plaintiff's Motion for Default Judgment, judgment is entered in favor of Plaintiff Securities and Exchange Commission and against Defendant Lambros D. Ballas.

Judgment is entered in the amount of \$6036, which consists of \$1507 in disgorgement, \$2 in prejudgment interest, and \$4527 in civil penalties.

Defendant Lambros D. Ballas and his agents, servants, employees, those with powers of attorney on his behalf, and all persons in active concert or participation with any of them, who receive actual notice of this Judgment, by personal service or otherwise, and each of them, are permanently enjoined and restrained from, directly or indirectly, in connection with the purchase or sale of any securities, by the use of any means or instrumentality of interstate commerce, or of the mails, or of any facility of any national securities exchange:

1. Issuing or causing to be disseminated, in any manner, unauthorized or false or misleading press releases, or other public statements regarding publicly-traded or quoted companies; or

1 2. Posting on the Internet, including, but not limited to Internet message boards, any
2 false or misleading information, including, but not limited to: links to unauthorized or
3 false or misleading press releases, or other public statements, regarding publicly-
4 traded or quoted companies;
5 where such conduct would constitute an actual or threatened violation of Section 10(b) of the
6 Securities Exchange Act of 1934, 15 U.S.C. § 78j(b), and the Exchange Act Rule 10b-5, 17 C.F.R. §
7 240.10b-5.
