1 The Securities and Exchange Commission ("SEC") having filed a complaint, as amended, and Defendant Lobsang Dargey ("Defendant") and Relief Defendant Path Othello, LLC ("Relief 2 Defendant") having each entered a general appearance; consented to the Court's jurisdiction over 3 4 Defendant and Relief Defendant and the subject matter of this action; consented to entry of this 5 Final Judgment pursuant to the Consent to Final Judgment as to Defendant Lobsang Dargey and Relief Defendant Path Othello, LLC ("Consent"); waived findings of fact and conclusions of law; 6 7 and waived any right to appeal from this Final Judgment: 8 9 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that Defendant is permanently restrained and enjoined from violating, directly or indirectly, Section 10(b) of the 11 Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (the "Exchange Act"), 15 U.S.C. § 78j(b), and Rule 10b-5, 17 C.F.R. § 240.10b-5, by using any means or instrumentality of interstate commerce, or of the 12 mails, or of any facility of any national securities exchange, in connection with the purchase or 13 sale of any security: 14 15 to employ any device, scheme, or artifice to defraud; (a) to make any untrue statement of a material fact or to omit to state a material fact 16 (b) necessary in order to make the statements made, in the light of the circumstances under 17 which they were made, not misleading; or 18 to engage in any act, practice, or course of business which operates or would 19 (c) 20 operate as a fraud or deceit upon any person. 21 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that, as provided in Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 65(d)(2), the foregoing paragraph also binds the following who receive 22 23 actual notice of this Final Judgment by personal service or otherwise: (a) Defendant's officers, agents, servants, employees, and attorneys; and (b) other persons in active concert or participation 24 with Defendant or with anyone described in (a). 25 П. 26

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that Defendant is

permanently restrained and enjoined from violating Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933

(the "Securities Act"), 15 U.S.C. § 77q(a), in the offer or sale of any security by the use of any 1 means or instruments of transportation or communication in interstate commerce or by use of the 2 3 mails, directly or indirectly: to employ any device, scheme, or artifice to defraud; 4 (a) 5 (b) to obtain money or property by means of any untrue statement of a material fact or any omission of a material fact necessary in order to make the statements made, in light of 6 the circumstances under which they were made, not misleading; or 7 to engage in any transaction, practice, or course of business which operates or 8 (c) 9 would operate as a fraud or deceit upon the purchaser. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that, as provided in Federal 10 11 Rule of Civil Procedure 65(d)(2), the foregoing paragraph also binds the following who receive actual notice of this Final Judgment by personal service or otherwise: (a) Defendant's officers, 12 agents, servants, employees, and attorneys; and (b) other persons in active concert or participation 13 with Defendant or with anyone described in (a). 14 Ш. 15 16 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that Defendant is permanently restrained and enjoined from, directly or indirectly, soliciting any person or entity to purchase or sell, 17 or from participating in the issuance, offer, or sale, of any security of any entity controlled by him 18 such that Defendant has the ability to direct the actions of the entity, including through participation 19 20 in its management or ownership of the entity's securities, or through any contract or other 21 arrangement regarding its securities; provided, however, that such injunction shall not prevent Defendant from purchasing securities for or selling securities from his own personal account. 22 23

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that, as provided in Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 65(d)(2), the foregoing paragraph also binds the following who receive actual notice of this Final Judgment by personal service or otherwise: (a) Defendant's officers, agents, servants, employees, and attorneys; and (b) other persons in active concert or participation with Defendant or with anyone described in (a).

IV. 1 2 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that Defendant is liable for 3 disgorgement of \$17,600,000, as a result of the conduct alleged in the complaint, as amended, together with prejudgment interest thereon in the amount of \$791,182, for a total of \$18,391,182, 4 5 but that this amount shall be deemed satisfied by: (1) Defendant's relinquishment of all legal and equitable right, title, and interest in all properties, businesses, funds and assets currently controlled 6 by the Court Appointed Receiver in this action ("Receiver") as set forth in Annex B to the 7 Consent; and (2) the order of restitution described in Paragraph 11 of the Plea Agreement (attached 8 9 as Annex A to the Consent) in *United States v. Lobsang Dargey* (W.D. Wash.) (which shall not be altered or affected by this Final Judgment). 10 V. 11 12 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that, within seven days of the entry of this Final Judgment, Defendant will execute a document reasonably suitable to the 13 SEC conveying to the receivership estate in this action all right, title and interest in all properties, 14 businesses, funds and assets over which the Receiver currently has control, as identified in Annex 15 16 B to the Consent. 17 VI. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that the Order Granting 18 19 Motion for Preliminary Injunction (ECF No. 68) (including all subsequent modifications to that Order) is hereby dissolved as to Defendant and Relief Defendant and is no longer of any force or 20 21 effect as to either of them, including the provision freezing their assets. All banks, financial 22 institutions, and brokerage firms are hereby notified that the asset freeze is no longer in effect as to the Defendant and as to the Relief Defendant. 23 VII. 24 25 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that the Consent is incorporated herein with the same force and effect as if fully set forth herein, and that Defendant 26 and Relief Defendant shall comply with all of the undertakings and agreements set forth therein. 27

VIII. 1 2 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that, for purposes of 3 exceptions to discharge set forth in Section 523 of the Bankruptcy Code, 11 U.S.C. § 523, the 4 allegations in the complaint, as amended, are true and admitted by Defendant, and further, any 5 debt for disgorgement, prejudgment interest, civil penalty or other amounts due by Defendant under this Final Judgment or any other judgment, order, consent order, decree or settlement 6 7 agreement entered in connection with this proceeding, is a debt for the violation by Defendant of 8 the federal securities laws or any regulation or order issued under such laws, as set forth in Section 9 523(a)(19) of the Bankruptcy Code, 11 U.S.C. §523(a)(19). 10 IX. 11 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that this Court shall retain 12 jurisdiction of this matter for the purposes of enforcing the terms of this Final Judgment. 13 X. 14 There being no just reason for delay, pursuant to Rule 54(b) of the Federal Rules of Civil 15 Procedure, the Clerk is ordered to enter this Final Judgment forthwith and without further notice. 16 17 18 19 IT IS SO ORDERED: 20 21 22 Dated: 3 March 2017 23 JAMES L.
