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
It is hereby **ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED:** That for the reasons stated in the Court's Memorandum Order dated November 26, 2018, defendant's motion to dismiss is denied and plaintiff's motion for summary judgment is granted; Defendant is permanently restrained and enjoined from violating, directly or indirectly, Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 promulgated thereunder, by using any means or instrumentally of interstate commerce, or of the mails, or of any facility of any national securities exchange, in connection with the purchase or sale of any security: (i) to employ any device, scheme, or artifice to defraud; (ii) to make any untrue statement of a material fact or to omit to state a material fact necessary in order to make the statements made, in light of the circumstances under which they were made, not misleading; or (iii) to engage in any act, practice, or course of business that operates or would operate as a fraud or deceit upon any person; Defendant is ordered to disgorge his profits, with prejudgment interest, in the amount of \$1,670,483.98, but this order shall be deemed satisfied if the corresponding criminal case orders are satisfied; Finally, defendant is ordered to pay a civil penalty of \$1,576,445.98; accordingly, the case is closed.
