0	IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that, as provided in
1	Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 65(d)(2), the foregoing paragraph also binds the following who
2	receive actual notice of this Final Judgment by personal service or otherwise: (a) Defendant's
3	officers, agents, servants, employees, and attorneys; and (b) other persons in active concert or
4	participation with Defendant or with anyone described in (a).

6	IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that Defendant
7	is liable for disgorgement of \$10,000.00, representing profits gained as a result of the conduct
8	alleged in the Complaint, together with prejudgment interest thereon in the amount of \$875.36.
9	Defendant shall satisfy this obligation by paying \$10,875.36 to the Securities and Exchange
0	Commission within 14 days after entry of the Final Judgment.

and shall be accompanied by a letter identifying the case title, civil action number, and name of this Court; Kennedy's name as a defendant in this action; and specifying that payment is made pursuant to this Final Judgment.

Defendant shall simultaneously transmit photocopies of evidence of payment and case identifying information to the Commission's counsel in this action. By making this payment, Defendant relinquishes all legal and equitable right, title, and interest in such funds and no part of the funds shall be returned to Defendant. The Commission shall send the funds paid pursuant to this Final Judgment to the United States Treasury.

The Commission may enforce the Court's judgment for disgorgement and prejudgment interest by moving for civil contempt (and/or through other collection procedures authorized by law) at any time after 14 days following entry of this Final Judgment. Defendant shall pay post judgment interest on any delinquent amounts pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1961.

III.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that the Consent is incorporated herein with the same force and effect as if fully set forth herein, and that Defendant shall comply with all of the undertakings and agreements set forth therein.

IV.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that, for purposes of exceptions to discharge set forth in Section 523 of the Bankruptcy Code, 11 U.S.C. § 523, the allegations in the complaint are true and admitted by Defendant, and further, any debt for disgorgement, prejudgment interest, civil penalty or other amounts due by Defendant under this Final Judgment or any other judgment, order, consent order, decree or settlement agreement entered in connection with this proceeding, is a debt for the violation by Defendant of the federal securities laws or any regulation or order issued under such laws, as set forth in Section 523(a)(19) of the Bankruptcy Code, 11 U.S.C. § 523(a)(19).
